## A New Research Platform for European Cities. The Pioneer Alliance on SDG11


The Università luav di Venezia, in collaboration with the Veneto Region, is organizing an event to present the PIONEER Alliance's Research Platform to the Italian community in Brussels.

Università luav di Venezia, in collaboration with nine other European universities, has secured €14 million in funding through the European Universities Alliance under the Erasmus scheme. The project, known as the PIONEER Alliance, also involves the Veneto Region as a Supporting Partner, along with Unioncamere del Veneto and the Fondazione Venezia Capitale Mondiale della Sostenibilità as Associate Partners. The initiative aims to create a Knowledge Hub that strengthens the three key missions of universities: education, research, and third mission activities, with a focus on tackling the challenges of sustainable urban development (SDG 11).

Within the PIONEER Alliance project, Università luav di Venezia holds a strategic role as the Work Package Leader for the Research pillar. This position allows Università luav di Venezia to lead the development of a shared competitive research strategy and coordinate actions among the partner universities. Università luav di Venezia also plays a key role in fostering cooperation with local stakeholders, involving both public and private entities to identify new research and innovation paths that can generate tangible impacts. This leadership represents an opportunity to position Università luav di Venezia as a key player in the European research landscape, particularly regarding challenges linked to sustainable urban development.

The event "PIONEER Alliance: Università luav di Venezia and New Research Perspectives for European Cities" is designed to present the PIONEER project to the Italian community in Brussels, ensuring maximum impact and engagement with key institutions. The primary objective is to expand Università luav di Venezia's and the Veneto Region's network within the European context, strengthening their position in the research community dedicated to sustainable urban development. The event will also serve as a networking platform to build new strategic alliances in preparation for upcoming European funding opportunities.

The event is addressed to Representatives of the Italian community in Brussels, EU institution officials, members of universities and research centers, NGO representatives, public and private stakeholders interested in sustainable development policies, and participants aiming to strengthen their position in European research programs.

Part One - Presentation of the PIONEER Research Platform

Location: European Parliament

## Main Goals:

- Strengthen Università luav di Venezia and the Veneto Region's position within the European research community, with a competitive outlook for the future of urban sustainability.
- Address key challenges related to sustainability (SDG 11), focusing on climate adaptation, enhancement of socio-cultural and environmental heritage, and social inclusivity.
- Build synergies and strategic alliances in anticipation of new European funding for research and innovation in Veneto's cities.

Thematic Roundtables: Three sequential discussion tables, coordinated by Università luav di Venezia, each one dedicated to a specific area related to the sustainable development of cities (SDG 11). The debate will involve representatives from universities, public bodies, non-governmental organisations and private stakeholders. Key themes include:

- Climate Change and Cities 1.
- Socio-cultural and Environmental Heritage in Veneto Cities 2.
- **Inclusive and Accessible Cities**

Each of the tables will be oriented to reflect on four transversal issues:

- Research and Innovation a.
- Governance and Policies h.
- Territorial Synergies and Partnerships C.
- Tools and Financing

Each roundtable will address specific challenges, discussing practical approaches and concrete actions aimed at delivering tangible results. Università luav di Venezia will lead the discussions, collecting proposals and suggestions for future PIONEER Alliance activities.
