Living while studying at TH Köln

Housing



Student dorms

- Apply online in time!
- at least 6 months in advance
- spaces are limited – no guarantee
- Rent between €250 – 400/month
- keep looking for private housing



Good to know:

Students in Germany often live in shared apartments (“WG“) in which rent and running costs are shared by all.

- private housing market
- Rent between €350 – 600/month



Living while studying at TH Köln

Costs

- No tuition fees
- Semester fee of approx. € 300-350/ semester

The semester fee includes:

- Student ID
- semester ticket for trains and buses in the whole of Germany
- library card, sports program, Students' Union, Kölner Studierendenwerk

Living costs

- Depend on personal needs, habits and lifestyle
- You should calculate with approx. **€ 1000-1500** per month
- International students will need proof of 992€/month
